

# Family Driving Ground Rules *make for* Safer Prom & Graduation Nights

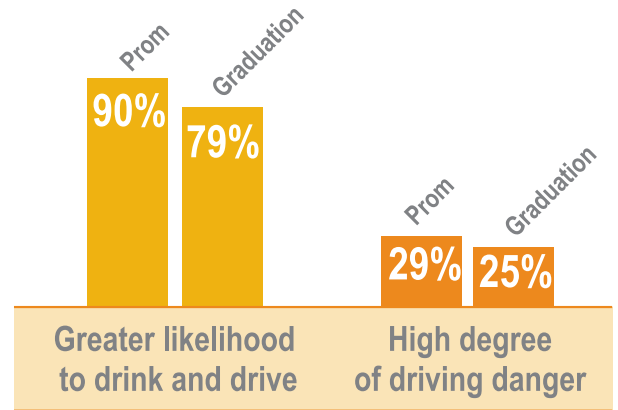


## 90%

of teens believe their counterparts are more likely to drink and drive on prom night

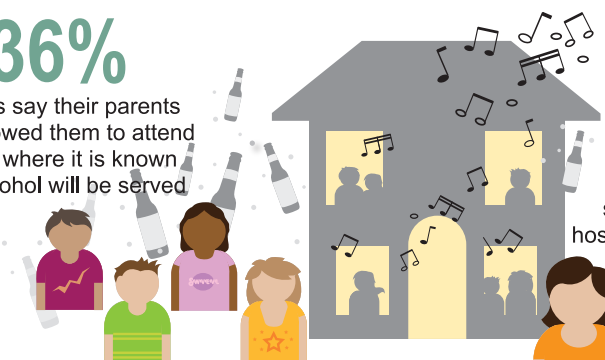
**However...**

only 29% believe driving on prom night comes with a high degree of danger



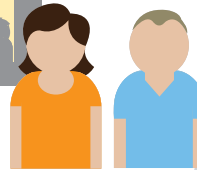
## 36%

say their parents have hosted such teen gatherings.

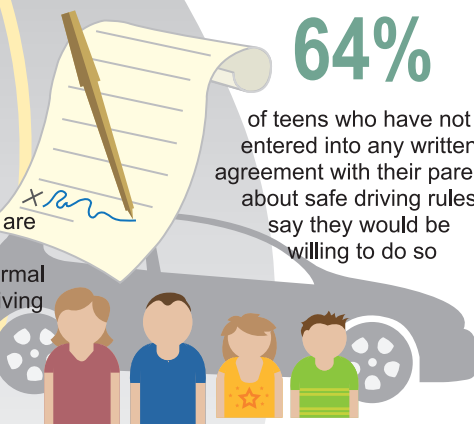


## 64%

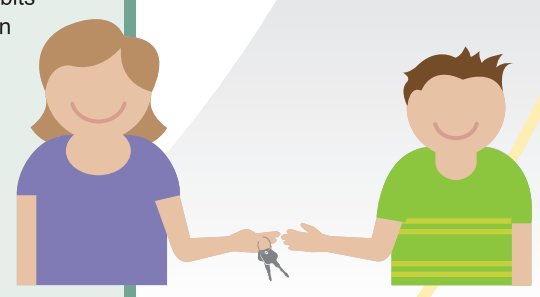
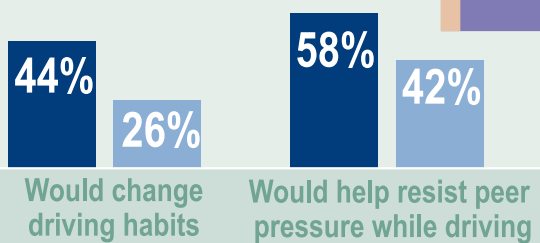
of teens admit they are not responsible for abiding by any formal or informal family driving safety rules



### Safe Driving Agreements Work!

Teens who have established driving rules with their parents are significantly more likely than those who do not to say a safe driving agreement would encourage them to change their driving habits and help them to resist peer pressure when making decisions behind the wheel.

### About the Liberty Mutual/SADD Teen Driving Survey

The Liberty Mutual/SADD teen driving survey was conducted in the Fall of 2009. The study involved surveying a total of 2,531 teens in eleventh and twelfth grades from 25 randomly recruited high schools across the country. These findings can be interpreted with a 95 percent confidence interval with an error margin of +/- 1.7 percent.
